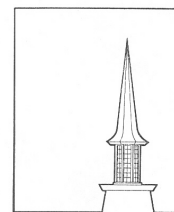

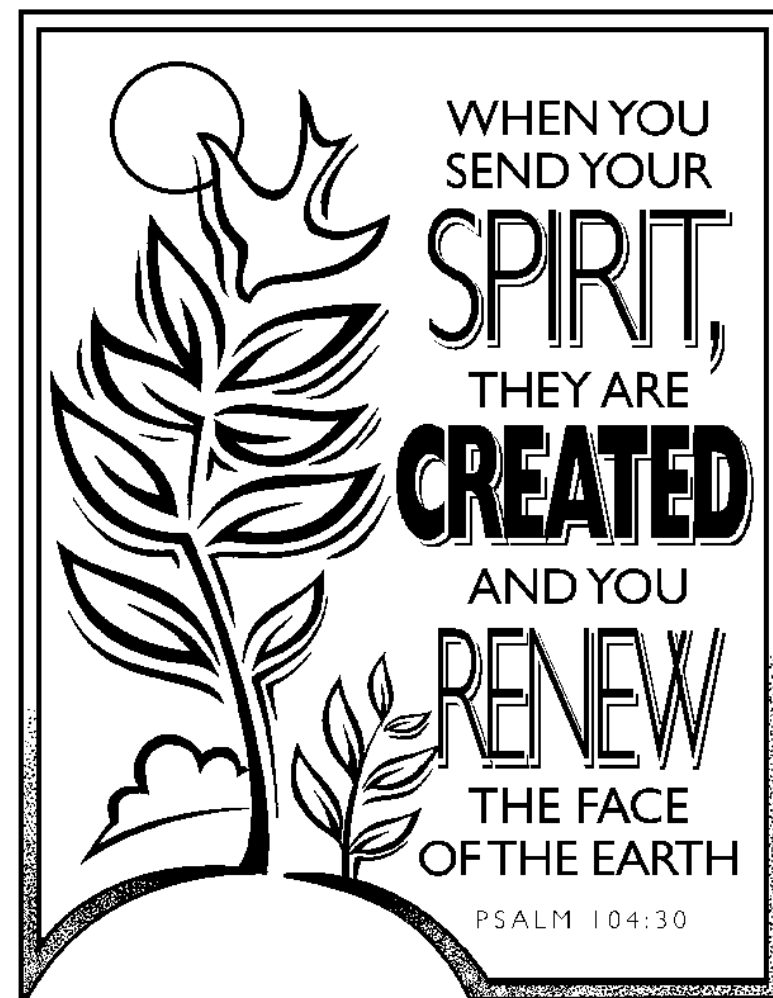

While the full totals are not yet known, Pinto church donated a significant amount toward the goal. Our Penny Power offering which we collect each month totaled \$1,233.97 or 3,740 trees for Haiti which was the special project this year.



Quilts and crochet items donated to the sale by our group sold for a total of \$1600.00 (including a generous pre-sale donation). Betty Helmick and Bree Flowers worked very hard to make a large amount of coleslaw which was sold as a part of the meal on Saturday, and several of our members were spotted bidding on items at the auction.
